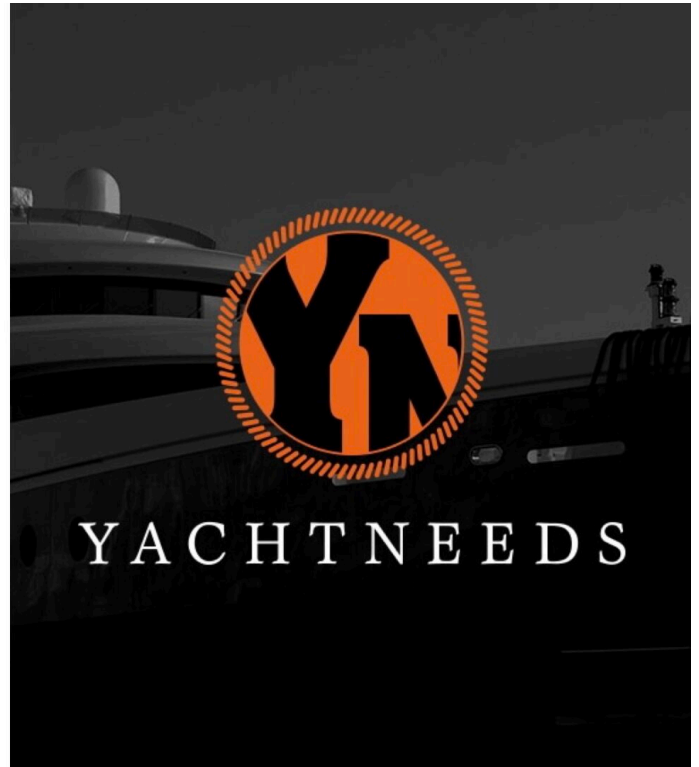


# A Message To Crew From The 2022 Yachtneeds Crew Party Sponsors
