
break.

5. Maora Beach, Bonifacio, Corsica

A short trip from the marinas of Bonifacio will take you to this little beach haven on the other side of the island, in a little bay on the Gulf of Santa Manza. You have a choice between a sun lounger on the manicured sand overlooking the turquoise sea, or relaxing on a daybed enjoying views of the lush gardens to the rear. The al-fresco restaurant on the water serves a delicious choice of fresh seafood, meats, pasta, and risottos. Visitors can follow this with an array of

tempting desserts. If you have a surge of energy, you can rent boats, kayaks, and paddleboards, or browse in the onsite shop. For the less energetic, a massage and wellbeing area offers a full menu of treatments to help you enjoy a lazy afternoon.
